## HIGH SIERRA RADIO CONTROL CLUB FREQUENCY CONTROL BOARD

Use of the frequency control board while flying at this field is mandatory for all flyers.

IF YOU ARE FLYING ON THE 72 MHZ frequencies ( channels 11 through 60 ) please put your AMA card on the frequency control board in the appropriate slot under the channel number you are flying on. Example: If you are flying on channel 32 put your AMA card in the slot under the number 32 on the board. If someone else's card is already in your frequency slot please contact that person BEFORE turning on your transmitter.

IF YOU ARE FLYING ON THE 2.4 MHZ FREQUENCY OR ANY FREQUENCY OTHER THAN THE 72 MHZ CHANNELS please place your AMA card in the slot at the bottom of the frequency board that coincides with the table number you are using. The table numbers are displayed at the front of each table.

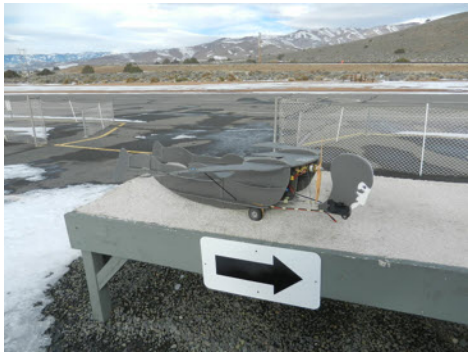
At the field.... Lots of interesting stuff going on....
