**Bob Sullivan** displayed his "Nobbler". This is a kit-built control line plane that has been modified for radio control. Apparently Bob bought this as a kid, surprisingly it was not just a box of dust. He started the build two years ago.

**Paul Ciotti** flew a drone around the meeting room. It is extremely light and you could catch it in your hand, only about 6". This drone was a scale model of the Millennium Falcon (Star Wars).

**Gary Fuller** showed a number of floats he has built from scratch. They are foam encased balsa that have aluminum angle stock rails on the top allowing for placement on different planes.
